

# 360 Communities 2016 At-a-Glance

## SCHOOL SUCCESS

During the 2016-2017 school year, Partners For Success® staff worked in **31 schools in 7 districts** and provided crisis stabilization, learning plans, and communication between home and school with **3,581 individuals, including 957 families and 2,105 students.**

In 2016, Dakota Healthy Families provided in-home visiting to **237 individuals**, promoting safe, healthy and nurturing homes that prepare children for kindergarten.

In 2016, Child Care Aware provided support and consultation to **135 child care providers**. 40 providers earned Parent Aware star ratings with extensive coaching from our staff.

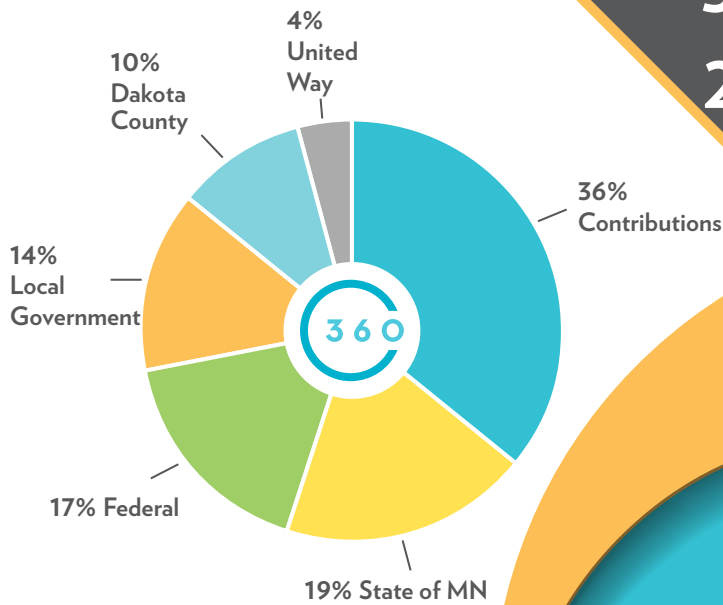

## SELF-SUFFICIENCY

In 2016, 360 Communities' network of five food shelves and two family resource centers served more than **12,951 individuals** with food and emergency relief.

**10,247 individuals** were served at our network of five food shelves in Apple Valley, Burnsville, Farmington, Lakeville and Rosemount.

Our resource center and food shelf customers have access to all 360 Communities programs and resources, ensuring that they have more opportunities to address the underlying cause of their current crisis.

## VIOLENCE PREVENTION

In 2016, 360 Communities Lewis House and outreach services provided shelter, counseling, court advocacy and more to **3,194 survivors of sexual and domestic violence.**

- **Lewis House** staff created safety plans for **3,166 individuals**
- **2,315 community members** benefited from Lewis House staff's violence prevention education.
- **431 sexual assault survivors** received counseling, legal advocacy, and resources. Lewis House staff provided 24-hour on-call assistance with medical and legal advocacy as well as long-term support.
