Fact Sheet

In 2018, there have been **12 deaths** due to domestic violence in Minnesota alone.

In 2017, there were 24.

Survivors of intimate partner violence lose a total of **8,000,000 million days** of paid work each year.

The equivalent of 32,000 full-time jobs.

Domestic violence hotlines receive over **20,000 calls** on average every day.

In 2017, with your help, 360 Communities has:

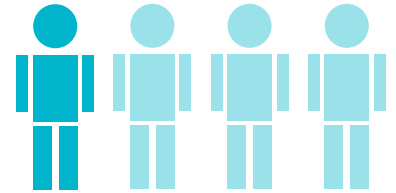
- Supported nearly **3,000 individuals** with violence prevention and intervention programming.

1 in 7 women and **1 in 25 men** have been **injured** by an intimate partner.

1 in 10 women have been **raped** by an intimate partner.

1 in 7 women and **1 in 18 men** have been **stalked**, causing them to feel unsafe.

1 in 5 people in the LGBTQ+ community have experienced **physical violence.**
